ALUMNAE SCHOLARSHIP HOUSE

You have been invited to participate in Alumnae Scholarship Housing (ASH) for the 2011-2012 academic year. There are many advantages to living in an Alumnae Scholarship House, and we hope that you will take advantage of this unique housing opportunity.

You have been welcomed into The Ohio State University ASH community based on your demonstrated academic ability and your estimated financial need. In order to be a part of this special tradition, you will need to complete a Residence Hall Contract from the Office of Housing Assignments. You must also indicate, on the contract, that you desire to live in an Alumnae Scholarship House.

In this cooperative environment, residents contribute five to eight hours per week to their living units. A total of fifty women live in the three Alumnae Scholarship Houses, which are the smallest of the cooperative scholarship units. Located on the south side of campus, Alumnae Scholarship Houses provide a family-like living experience for the female residents and a live-in staff member. Residents share responsibility for planning menus, ordering supplies, preparing meals, and housekeeping. In addition, the residents plan a variety of social activities and events. Because this is an academic environment, the work commitments do not in any way restrict residents from carrying full academic loads. It is important that you note that the award amount listed on your Award Notification for the Alumnae Scholarship House represents SAVINGS per term. It does **NOT** represent a credit to your account. However, you should also note that this SAVINGS per term is quite substantial.

SAVINGS from participation in the Alumnae Scholarship House is approximately \$1,850 per term in comparison to standard room and board rates incurred by students residing in other residence halls.
