DRUG CONVICTION RESOLUTION FORM

You reported on your FASFA that you have been convicted of possessing and/or selling drugs **while you were receiving federal student aid**. This makes you ineligible for federal student financial aid.

However, you may become eligible for federal student financial aid if you have:

- 1) Completed an acceptable drug rehabilitation program **OR**
- 2) One year has elapsed from the first conviction date or two years have elapsed from the second conviction date for the possession or sale of illegal drugs (cannot have more than 2 convictions) **OR**
- 3) Two years have elapsed from the first conviction date involving the sale of an illegal substance (cannot have more than 1 conviction) **OR**
- 4) The conviction has been removed from your record.

Note: An acceptable drug rehabilitation program must include at least 2 unannounced drug tests; and be qualified to receive funds from a federal, state or local government or from a federally or state-licensed insurance company; or be administered or recognized by a federal, state or local government agency or court, or a federally or state-licensed hospital, health clinic or medical doctor.

STUDENT STATEMENT
